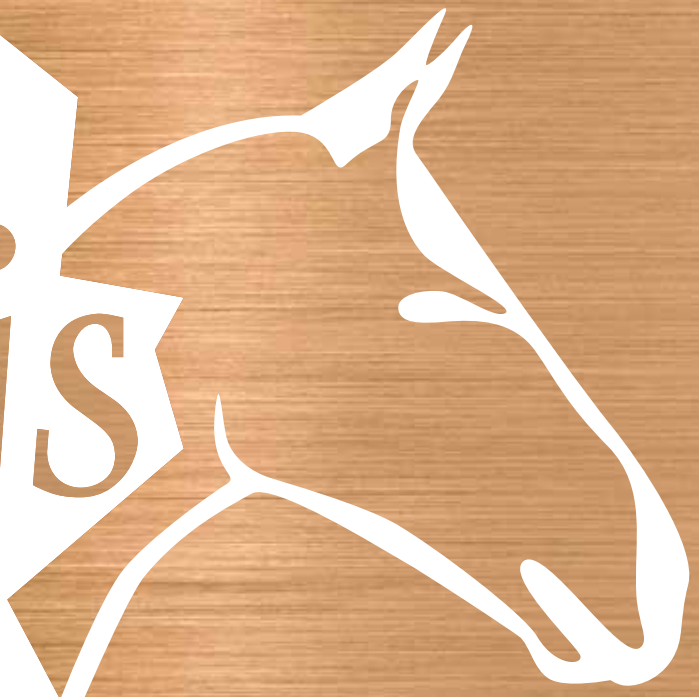

Genuine craftsmanship and selected materials



Our *beris* mouthpieces are made of food-safe plastic, with a finish and surface coating that is unmatched in plastic mouthpieces. The surface is particularly smooth and they glide easily in the mouth, even for horses that do not salivate much. The dreaded 'eraser effect' does not occur! Practically all horses like our mouthpieces; they salivate, chew more and are happy to approach the bit.

The side pieces are all hand-formed from stainless steel, welded and polished to a high shine.

The anatomically correct shape with comfortable placement in the horse's mouth and the use of high-quality materials tested for harmlessness characterise our *beris* bits.

The loving craftsmanship in our workshop in Schleswig-Holstein in the far north of Germany, enables us to continuously develop our bits and to offer individually tailored solutions for horses and riders. Of course, we pay particular attention to safety: the components of the bits are repeatedly tested for tensile strength and breaking load!

We are particularly proud of the modern aesthetics of our *beris* bits, which have become a perfect addition to the versatile equipment used in equestrian sports.

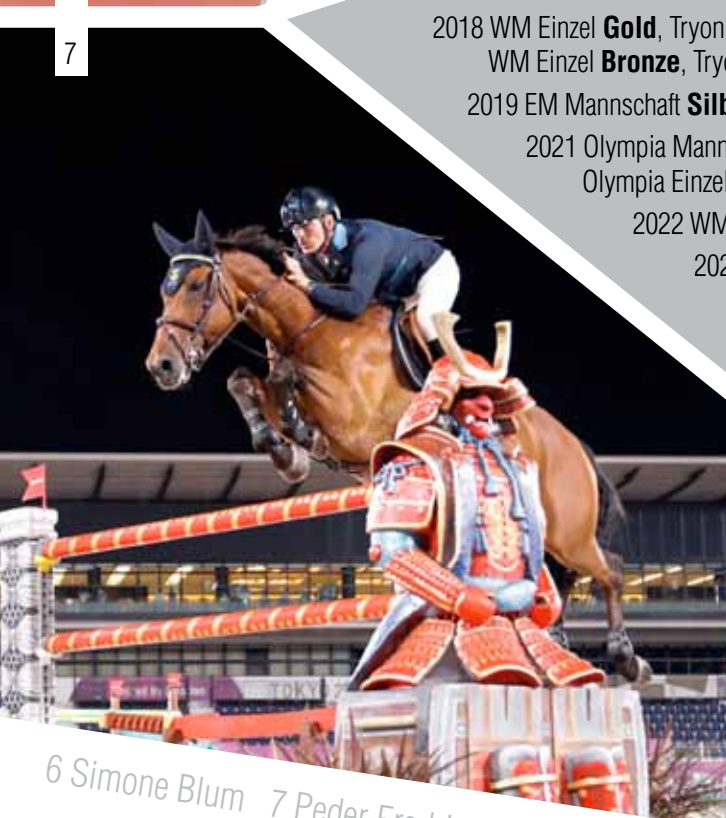

Our *beris* mouthpieces are developed with special attention to their gentle effect on the mouth and horse.

PRIME (extra soft)

The Prime sets new standards in communication between horse and rider. The anatomically correct, extremely soft mouthpiece distributes pressure evenly across the tongue and bars. Integrated oval bit discs with a carefully modelled transition to the centre piece prevent the lips from being pinched and give the bit particularly good lateral support.



PURE (extra soft)

The Pure was developed from our unique Prime. All the advantages of the super-soft Prime can be found in the Pure, only without the bit discs.

The Pure – almost limitless in its applications!



EGGBUT (soft, medium + hard)

The Eggbut is a universally applicable mouthpiece. It lies very quietly in the horse's mouth and the side olives effectively prevent the lips from being pinched. The surface of the plastic is highly tempered, very smooth and glides well in the mouth, even with horses that produce little saliva.

The mouthpiece, which has a wider contact surface on the tongue and lips, transitions smoothly into a rotated olive. Pinching of the lips is impossible!



SINGLE & DOUBLE JOINTED (medium)

Form and function meet design! Our single and double jointed plastic mouthpiece is particularly slim – a wide contact surface and low height ensure greater comfort, even in smaller horse mouths.

The joint and the centre piece are very finely crafted and mounted to match the low height of the mouthpiece. The copper bushings fitted into the side olives allow the bit rings to glide smoothly and with almost no resistance. Whether single or double jointed, both mouthpieces are delicately crafted with the utmost skill and impress with their gently modelled transitions. Precision rein control and gentle communication close to ideal with the single and double jointed bits from *beris*!



MULLEN MOUTH (soft + hard)

This anatomically correct mouthpiece rests evenly and lightly on the tongue and bars, offering the tongue more space and freedom of movement. When the reins are taken up, even pressure is applied to the lower jaw bars and tongue. There is no lateral constriction of the tongue and bars. The use of bit discs prevents the lips from being pinched.

The mullen mouth lies particularly quietly in the mouth thanks to its slightly curved shape. Mouthpieces with a slightly curved bar are considered particularly gentle and kind to the mouth. This feature, in combination with our beris plastic, allows horse and rider to communicate even more gently and comfortably. The mullen mouth is particularly suitable for young and sensitive horses.



MULLEN MOUTH *thin* (soft + hard)

Identical to the mullen mouth in terms of shape, but with a much thinner mouthpiece measuring just 15 mm. This makes the mouthpiece an ideal bit for ponies or horses with very little space in their mouths. Pony bits are also very successful when used as dressage bits for horses whose mouths are overloaded by a thick double bridle bit and a snaffle bit. It is also very successful when used as a dressage curb bit for horses whose mouths are overloaded by a thick curb bit and a snaffle bit.

Pony bits are manufactured with proportionally adjusted side pieces!

CONVERTO (soft + hard)

This mouthpiece is an anatomically correct, slightly curved rod that offers even more freedom on the tongue side with its evenly shaped bow.



KONNEX (soft + hard)

Combines the effect of a tongue bar with the positive characteristics of a butterfly. The profile of the Konnex is slimmer, it takes up less space and sits very comfortably in the horse's mouth – in addition, the bar is significantly wider to protect the tongue.



Suitable for horses with limited space, e.g. young or older horses (due to changes in tooth position), horses with thicker tongues and especially those that are sensitive to pressure on specific points of the tongue.

KONNEX *thin* (soft + hard)

Identical in design, we have slimmed down the Konnex thin to meet the needs of athletic ponies and thoroughbred type horses. The Konnex thin persuades with a thickness of only 15 mm on the lips and a proportionally slimmed-down tongue port.

TONGUE PORT (soft + hard)



Our tongue port has a special, flattened shape. This gives the tongue optimal space. Many horses respond to this with improved suppleness and increased chewing activity. This mouthpiece is therefore ideal for horses that are reluctant to tolerate conventionally shaped bits due to the pressure on the tongue and react by shaking their heads or similar.

The bit is also very well suited for so-called tongue players who try to stick their tongue over the bit, as the port effectively prevents this.

BUTTERFLY (soft + hard)



The butterfly is a completely new innovation in the field of mouthpieces. Its anatomically shaped recess, combined with the widened contact surface in the tongue area, provides this extremely important and sensitive muscle with maximum space and the possibility of very gentle action.

Horses show their well-being through increased chewing activity and increased contact with the bit. If a stronger effect is desired, a lever-action side piece can be used to change the angle of the mouthpiece in the mouth. The increased pressure at specific points allows the desired responsiveness to be achieved. When the pressure is released, the butterfly bar immediately returns to its comfortable position.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR PLASTIC MOUTHPIECES

The mouthpieces should be cleaned with clean water after each use.

LEATHERCOMFORT (soft + hard)



The anatomically pre-shaped mouthpiece adapts perfectly to the anatomy of the horse's mouth when wet. Our leather mouthpiece is particularly suitable for young and extremely sensitive horses. Even horses that are absolutely averse to snaffles usually accept a leather bit and can relearn how to approach the bit with confidence.

LEATHERKONNEX (soft + hard)



Unique worldwide! A mouthpiece made from a Konnex thin covered with a leather surface. The leather seam faces the palate, and the tongue area is additionally flattened. Leatherkonnex is the solution for horses that prefer this material and appreciate more space for their tongue.



CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR LEATHER MOUTHPIECES

The mouthpiece should be soaked in cooking oil for several hours before first use. Repeat this process as soon as the leather appears dry.

Before each use, soak it briefly in clean water and clean it thoroughly after use, as saliva can erode the leather.

Information Pony Bit

Our *beris* bits are, of course, also popular with ponies! All pony bits are manufactured with proportionally adjusted side pieces.



To buckle up the bit correctly

The bit is correctly buckled when the engraving is visible on the **left side** of the horse's mouth.

Due to the material:

Mouthpieces made of a plastic compound or leather are contrary to those made of metal significantly softer and weigh a lot less. This is what most horses love about these bits. But the horse's teeth are considerably harder than any plastic compound or leather and can shorten the lifespan of a mouthpiece made of these materials.

If the bit is correctly placed in the dental free area between the Incisors and Molars (Diastema), a damage done to the mouthpiece is quite unlikely, but caused by sharp edged-teeth not impossible.

For these reasons we cannot offer any warranty for damages due to bite marks or incorrect placement of the bit.



To Buckle Up The Bit Correctly



Loose Ring

A loose-running ring characterises our water snaffle.

A movable ring means greater mobility of the bit in the mouth. The water snaffle is therefore a bit for horses that prefer a more 'mobile' bit in their mouth. The ring runs very smoothly in the copper bushings of the plastic and leather bits and, thanks to its improved durability, significantly increases the service life of the bit.

The choice of mouthpiece allows you to further cater to the needs of your horse.

Eggbutt Snaffle

The Eggbutt sides give the bit **particularly stable lateral support** and the gently modelled transition from the mouthpiece to the bit rings makes it **impossible for the lips to get caught**. The shape and the different ring sizes make this bit **particularly suitable for working with young horses**.

With a small ring, the rider's hand has a faster and more direct effect due to the shorter travel distance, while with a larger ring, the effect of the rider's hand is softened. The Eggbutt Snaffle can also be adapted to almost any type of horse thanks to the different degrees of hardness of the mouthpiece.

3-Ring

Combines **effective lateral restraint, leverage and winding up in one bit**. The degree of impact is selected by the various rein attachment options. When attached to the lower ring, the asking rein aid exerts a short lever action on the bit.

The 3-ring bit is often used to test the horse's reaction to a lever effect.

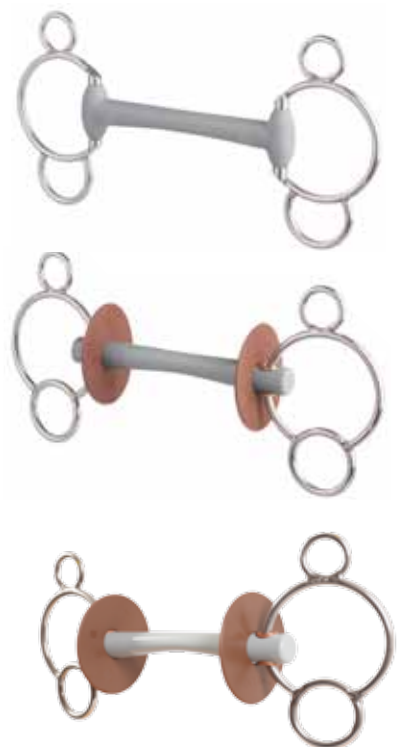

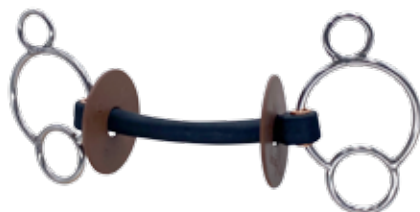

D-Ring

The shape and weight of the side pieces ensure **a very calm, neutral position in the mouth.**

This feature makes the bit ideal **for young horses that are still somewhat inexperienced.** The shape of the side pieces also provides them with optimal lateral support and guidance. Sensitive and calm rein control is facilitated by the large ring.

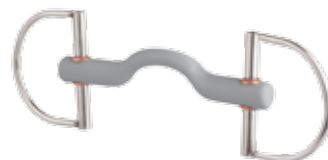

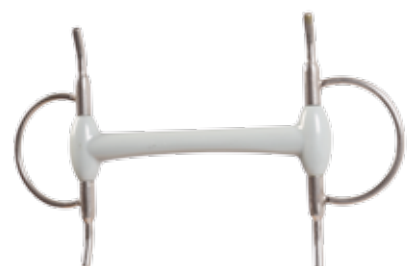
Full Cheek

The bit **sits very calmly and stably in the mouth**. It provides reliable lateral restraint **without the risk of pinching the skin and lips** thanks to the angled bars. This bit is suitable for horses that need clear lateral support and guidance when turning. These can be strong horses as well as young, inexperienced horses.

This bit is preferred by show jumpers to enable them to ride fast turns.

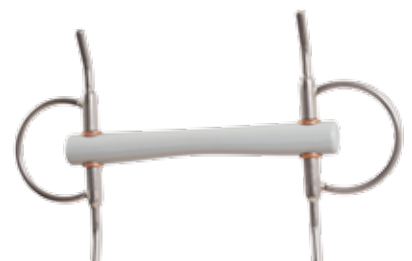

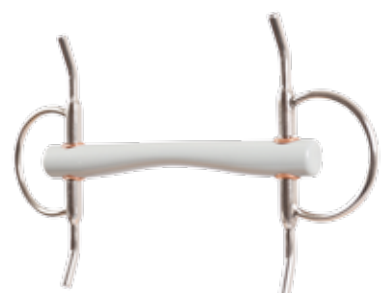

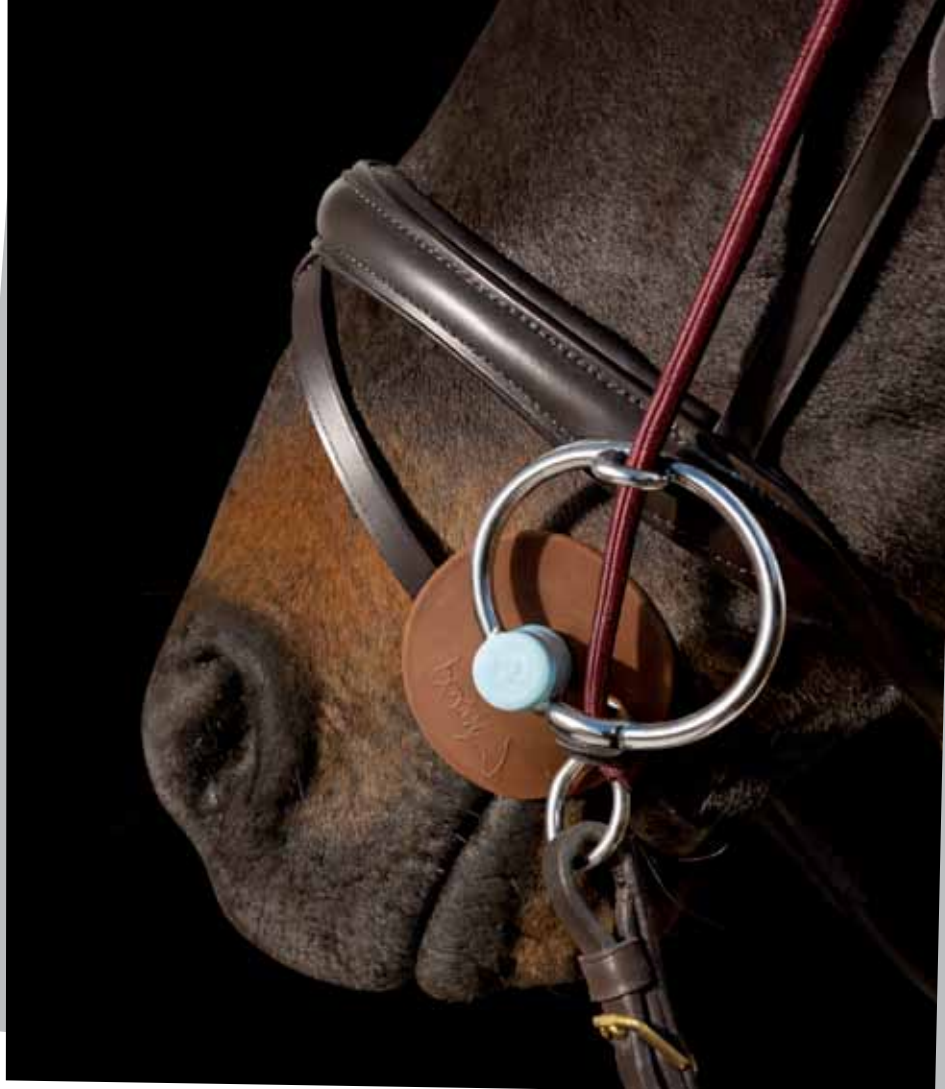

Kimblewick

The spring combination bit is an **effective combination of leverage on the lower jaw, pressure on the poll and a change in the position of the bit in the horse's mouth.**

Three different fastening options allow for precise control of the bit. The solid side pieces give the bit a certain 'heaviness' that ensures a calmer position in the mouth.

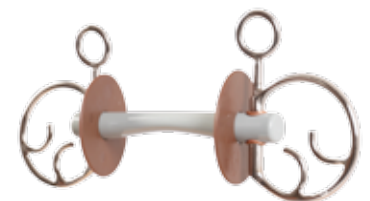

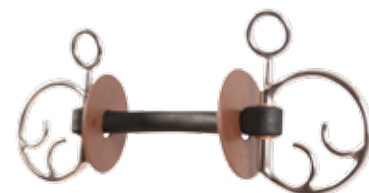

Kombi

This bit ensures **optimal pressure distribution on the lower jaw and mouth** and is very well accepted by the horse. The second rein acts like a chin strap that can be taken up or released as needed. This bit is very well suited for particularly strong and pushing forward horses.

The double-jointed design allows the bit to move freely in the horse's mouth, preventing it from choking the horse.

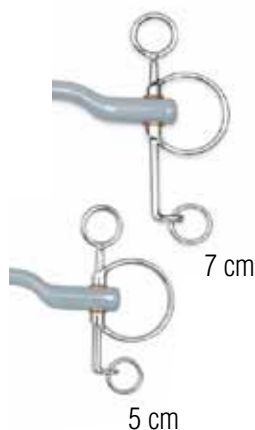
Pelham

A classic with a refined, more elegant design.

When the reins are taken up, the bit acts on the mouth, lower jaw and neck. Depending on the lever length of the shanks (5 cm or 7 cm), a different degree of strength and immediate bit angulation can be achieved in the mouth. Can be **used on horses that have difficulty yielding through the neck, on 'hot' horses or on horses that need a clear response in critical situations** (jumping, etc.).

The Pelham is supplied with chin chain hooks attached.

We manufacture the **Pelham** with short (5 cm) and long (7 cm) shanks and equip it with a chin chain hook.

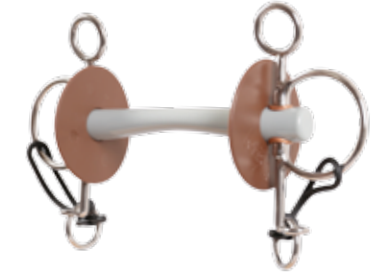

Filet

The upper part of our fillet snaffle is very similar to a Pelham.

As with the Pelham, the cheek piece is buckled into the upper, small ring. Unlike the Pelham, however, the rein does not act on the bit via a lever and therefore exerts hardly any pressure on the neck. **Horses that are sensitive to pressure on the neck will usually be more comfortable with this bit.**

It sits extremely quietly in the mouth and **encourages horses that carry their head very high** to lower it and become more supple in the neck.

Autopilot

The Autopilot, newly developed by us, automatically positions the mouthpiece in the horse's mouth in the way that **only the slightest pressure is applied to the tongue and lower jaw.**

The anatomy of the mouth varies, as do preferences for the position of the mouthpiece. **The horse can now actively determine the position of the mouthpiece.** Although taking up the reins increases the pressure on the tongue and lower jaw, the position of the mouthpiece in the horse's mouth that is most comfortable for the horse remains unchanged! The use of a chin strap or chin chain significantly reduces pressure on the neck.
